- 1.3 Cookies on Our Site are not permanent and will usually expire within 30 minutes (some third party cookies may expire within 24 hours)

JSESSIONID	Enables users to be logged out after inactivity	Yes
XSRF-TOKEN	Prevents cross-site request forgery	Yes
